## **Browser test room**

The browser test room has been created to allow you to test your audio and video, in preparation for joining a videoconference via your browser.

## Entering the browser test room

There are several ways that you can enter test room. There is a public virtual room, which is available 24/7.

If you are **logged into Vscene**, you can simply go to the **'Video Systems'** tab, and choose **Browser video test**.

Alternatively, if you have been sent an email invitation to join a videoconference as a guest, you can go to **vscene.jisc.ac.uk** and click on the 'Browser video test' at the bottom of the web page.

If you have a link to join a conference, you can click on the link in advanced to go to the browser test room.

## **Device settings**

Before joining the test room, you should select your camera, microphone and speaker settings. Vscene should automatically detect any devices connected to your PC. We recommend using a headset when using any browser-based system. We also suggest using any browser except Chrome.
