


## The Portal How to use it

# Default view This is what you see by default










### Organisation view How to use it

- Service Realms
  - > Your services/service groups at your organisation
- »ID Provider Realms
  - > Identity realms provided by your organisation
- » Credential, Admins, Moderated Edits
  - Download your Trust Router credential here
  - > Add and delete management contacts here
  - > See an audit log of changes (pending/rejected)



### Service Realms view






## Service Realms view How to use it

- » Name: Description of your group of services
- »Realm: This is identical to 'rp\_realm' in 'mods-available/ realm' module in FreeRADIUS configuration
- »Domain Constraints: The 'gss\_acceptor\_host\_name' setting in 'sites-available/abfab-tls' clients section has to match these constraints. Can use a wildcard (easier).
- You can enable/disable realms
- >> Each service realm needs its own RP Proxy



### **ID Provider Realms view**






## ID Provider Realms view How to use it

- » Name: Description of your ID realm
  - > Can just be your realm name too
- » Realm: This is what's to the right of the @-sign
- » AAA Server: The server that will handle this realm
  - > This is your actual Moonshot IdP server!
- >> You can enable/disable the realms too

## Credential view How to use it

- » Click the button to download the credential!
- » Only one credential needed per organisation
- >> The XML file is imported with moonshot-webp to the radiusd/freerad and trustrouter users
- >> You will get a new credential every time you click
  - This is for security Makes credential compromises difficult
- >> Management contacts should share the file amongst themselves (remember security!)




## Admins view How to use it

- » Jisc will add your management contacts in the application form for you
- >> You can invite others:
  - > Add email address of contact, hit Enter
- >> Invited users listed on the right
  - > Expired invites are listed as scratched out
- Click on the (x) to delete a contact
- >> Management contact logins associated with invite after first logon with UKAMF.

## Moderated Edits view How to use it

- »Lists pending edits, rejected edits with reasons why
- >> It's an audit log for you
- Actions that need approval from Jisc:
  - Adding ID or service realms
  - > Adding domain constraints
- »Why??
  - This is a trust network, we can't have someone claiming to be Google.com unless it's actually Google!

### Communities view How to use it

- Give community a name (camford.communities.moonshot...)
- >> Choose an APC you're part of
- » Choose IdPs and Services (here human-readable names are useful)
- » Communities don't need Jisc approval



## Communities view How to use it

- >>> RP Proxies are always part of the default APC community
- Default APC community is in 'mods-available/realm' 'default\_community' setting in FreeRADIUS
- » Jisc will tell you what your default APC community is
- >> Your services themselves can be part of different communities, set in 'sites-available/abfab-tls' client section, 'trust\_router\_coi' setting (set to same as 'default\_community' until different one needed).
