  - 23rd April

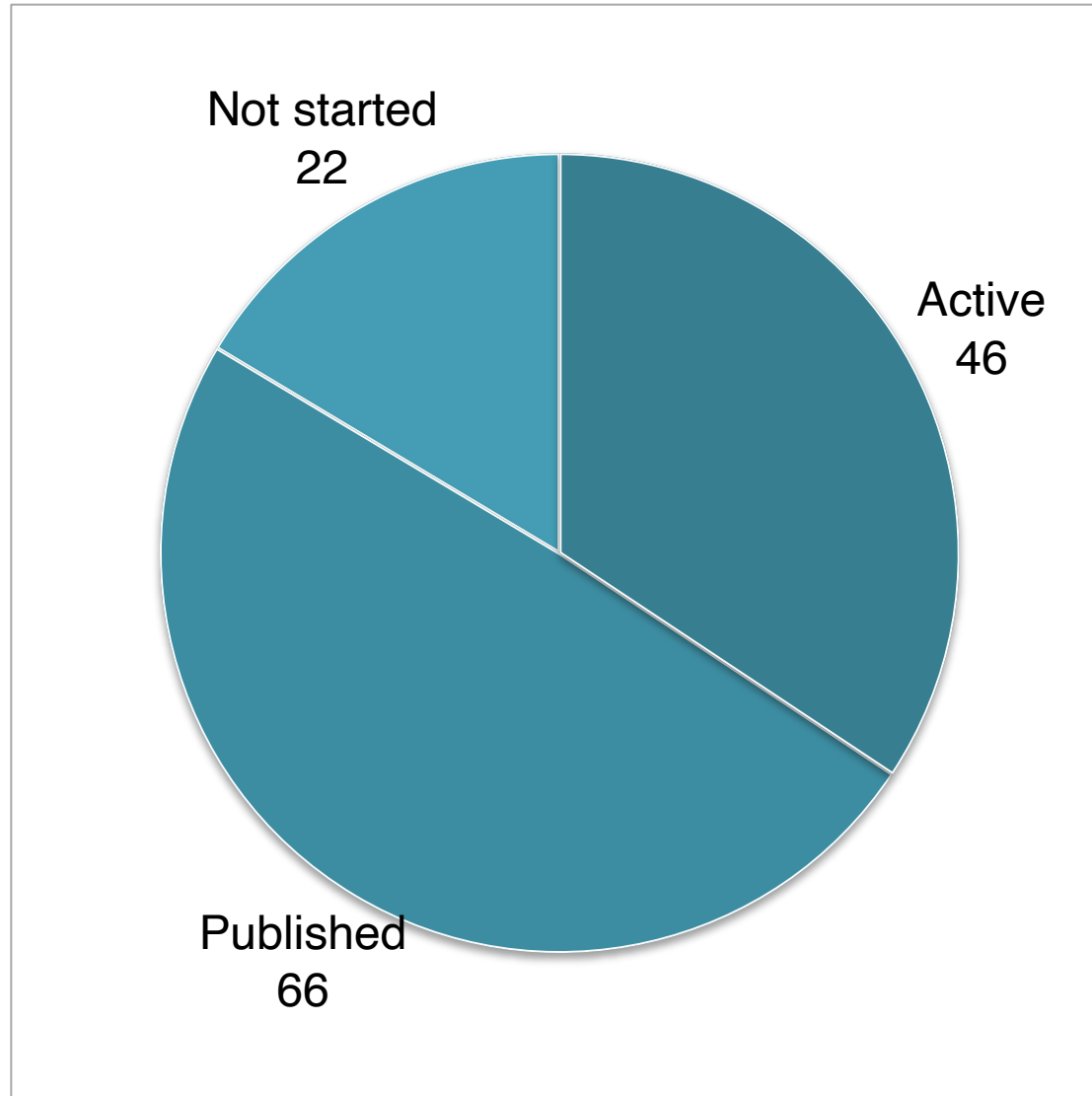
# Community Activities

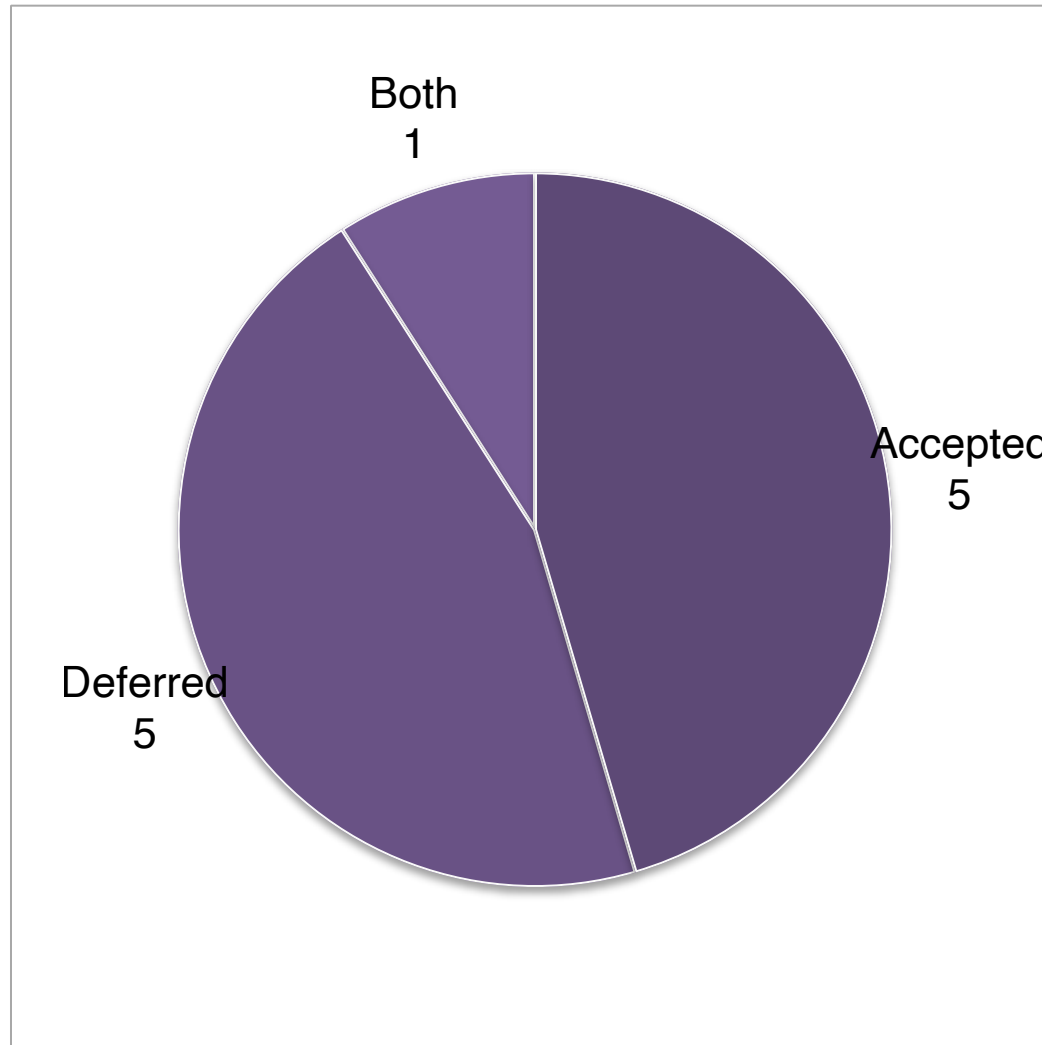
