- Opportunity to review security policies

# Negative experiences



- Time-consuming
- Bureaucracy
- Self-assessment
- Lack of advice and feedback
- Scope/Applicability
- Relevance
- Buy-in
- Compliance not an indicator of security

# Messages

- The process is not one to be taken lightly
- Ongoing investment required
- Key thing is the information asset register
- Will not guarantee adequate information security
- Designed for NHS Trusts
- 27001 compliance can really help

# **UCL PLANS AND PROGRESS**

# EpiLab

- Certified as of 23rd April
- Built on existing 27001 certification
- Took less than six months
- Of the required controls:
  - 4 at Level 3 (fully compliant)
  - 7 at Level 2 (mostly there, improvement plan required)
  - 2 not applicable
  - 1 exempt

# IDHS Project

- School of Life and Medical Sciences
- Working closely with UCL partners
- Central resource for research project compliance
  - Template documents
  - Technical solution
  - Training and awareness

# Progress of IDHS Project

- SIRO being appointed
- Integrating with EpiLab
- Finding more areas
- Building into research bid process
- Due Aug/Sept 2013
