- *change in balance of funding*



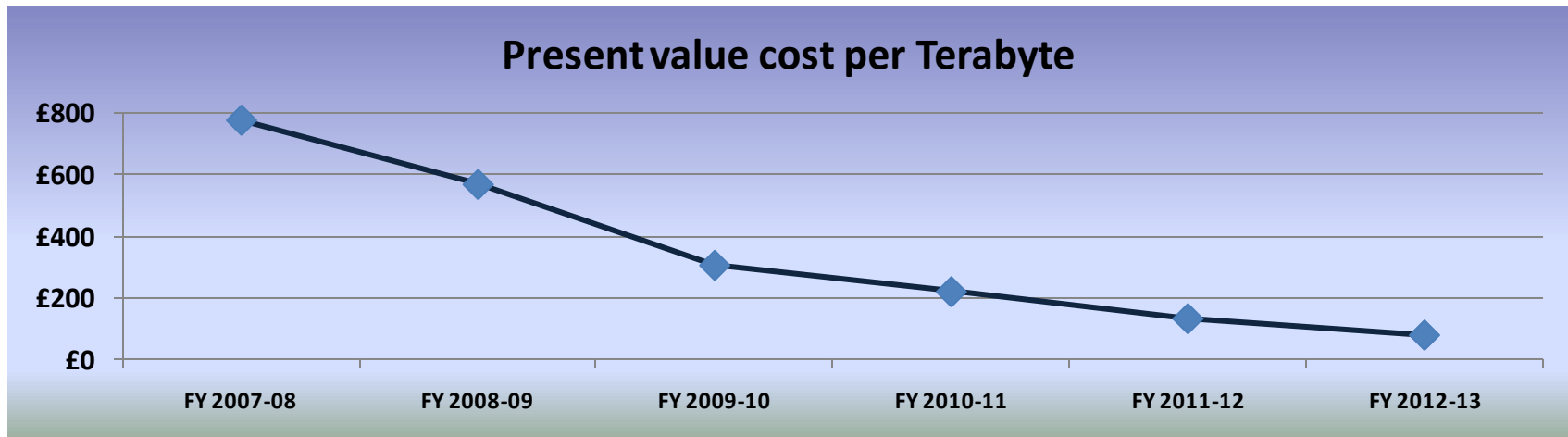
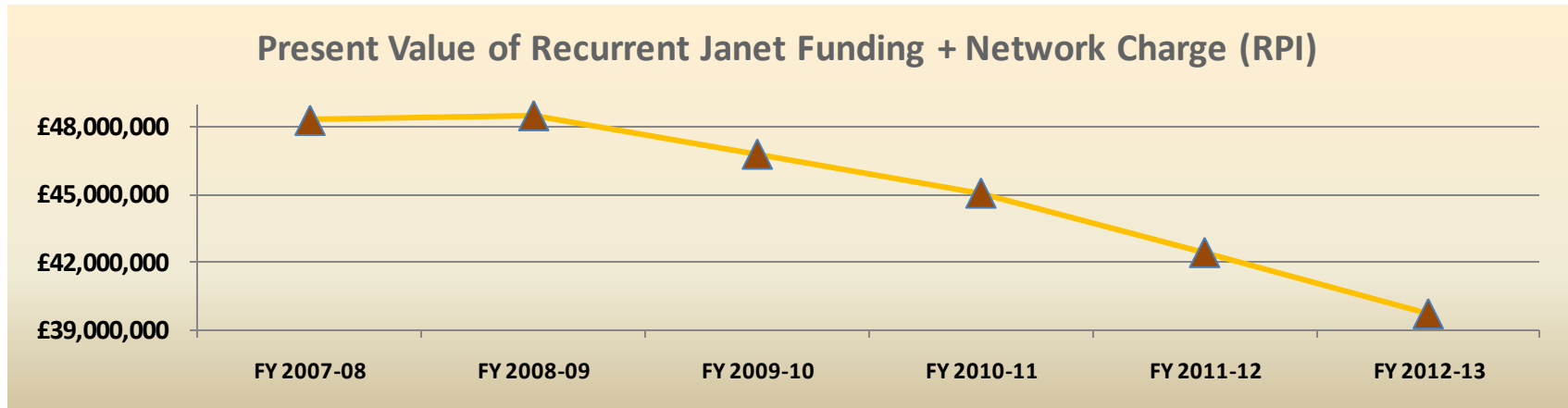

- “...the aggregator model – **generates at least £11.1m pa savings.**”
- “...270 organisations use the Janet email filtering service – **net saving of £1.6m pa.**”

- “...Janet services **1,200 connections for £62m**....applying a similar analysis to SURFnet (270 connections serviced for £28m) suggests comparable provision would cost £120m.“ – **48% efficiency**

- “achieving savings from restructuring the supply chain combined with greater contribution from non-SLA charges contributed **£10m of net benefit, enabling Network Charges to remain unchanged for four years (2007-10)**”
- “...Janet was able to offer internet access for local authorities for **half the price of commercial providers.**”

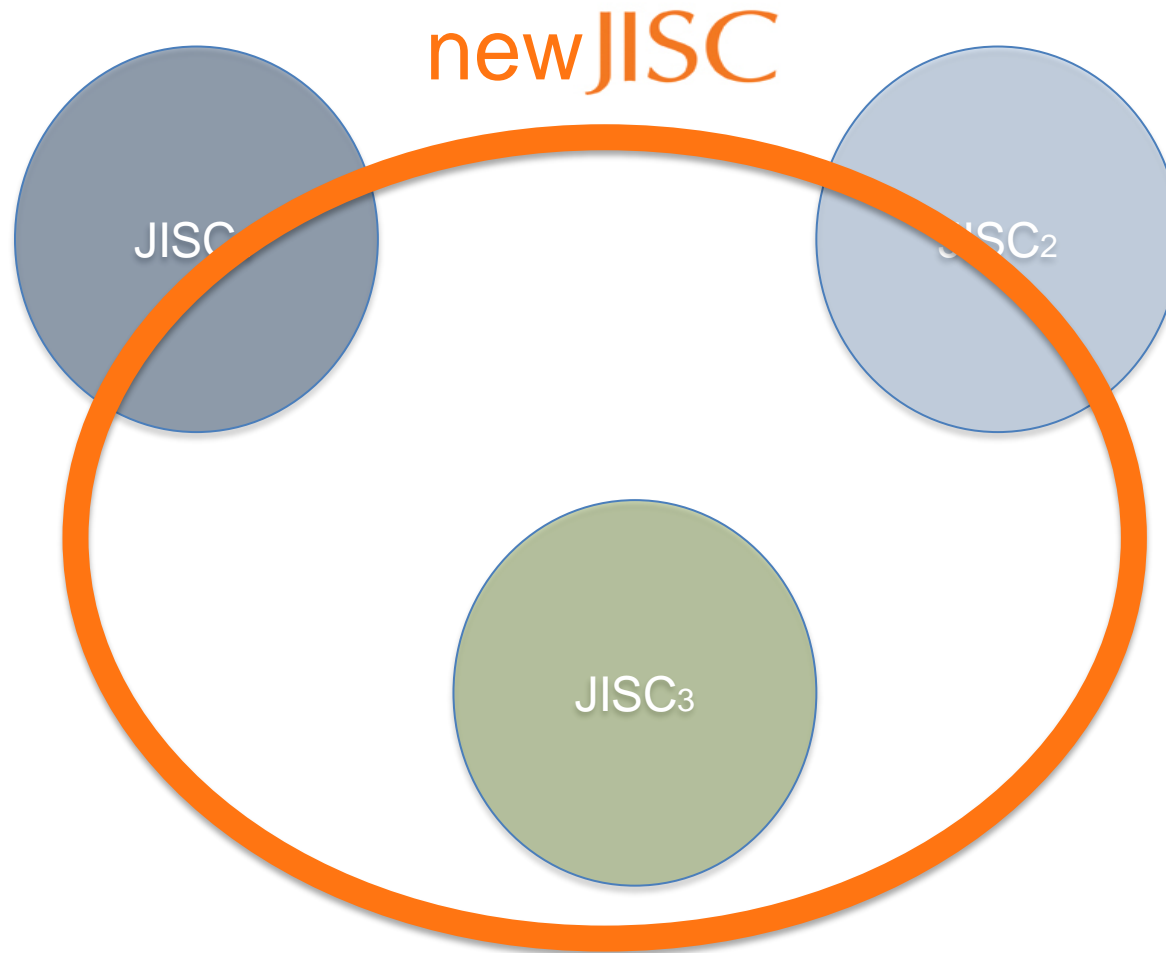

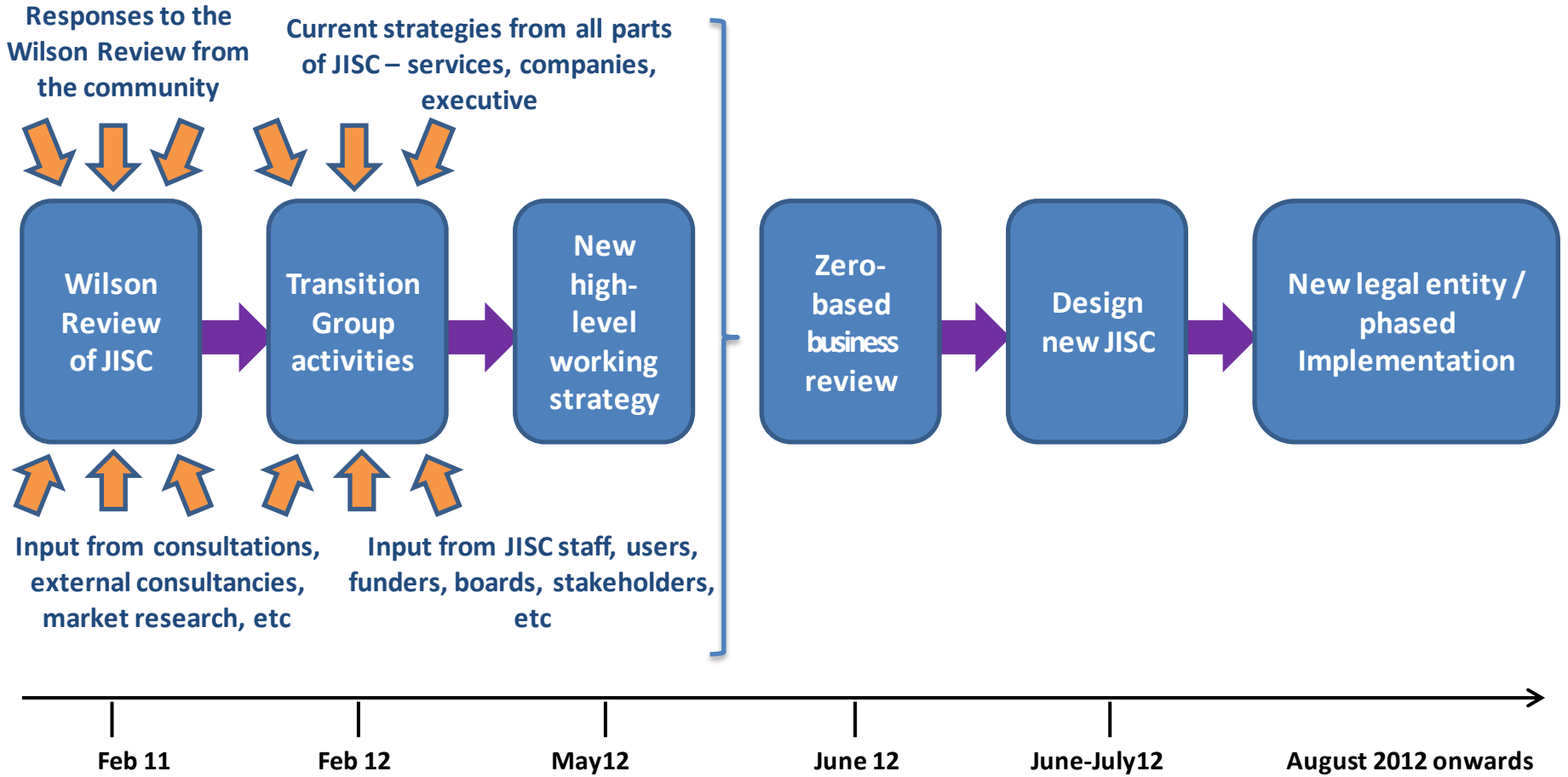
