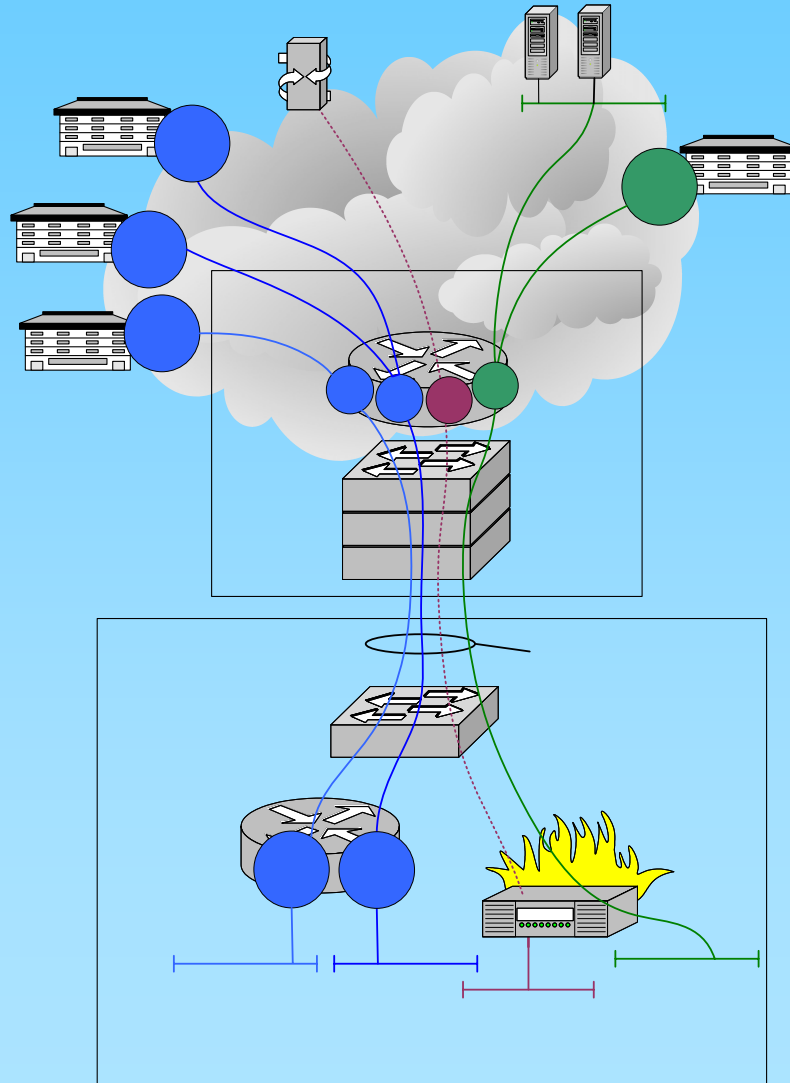

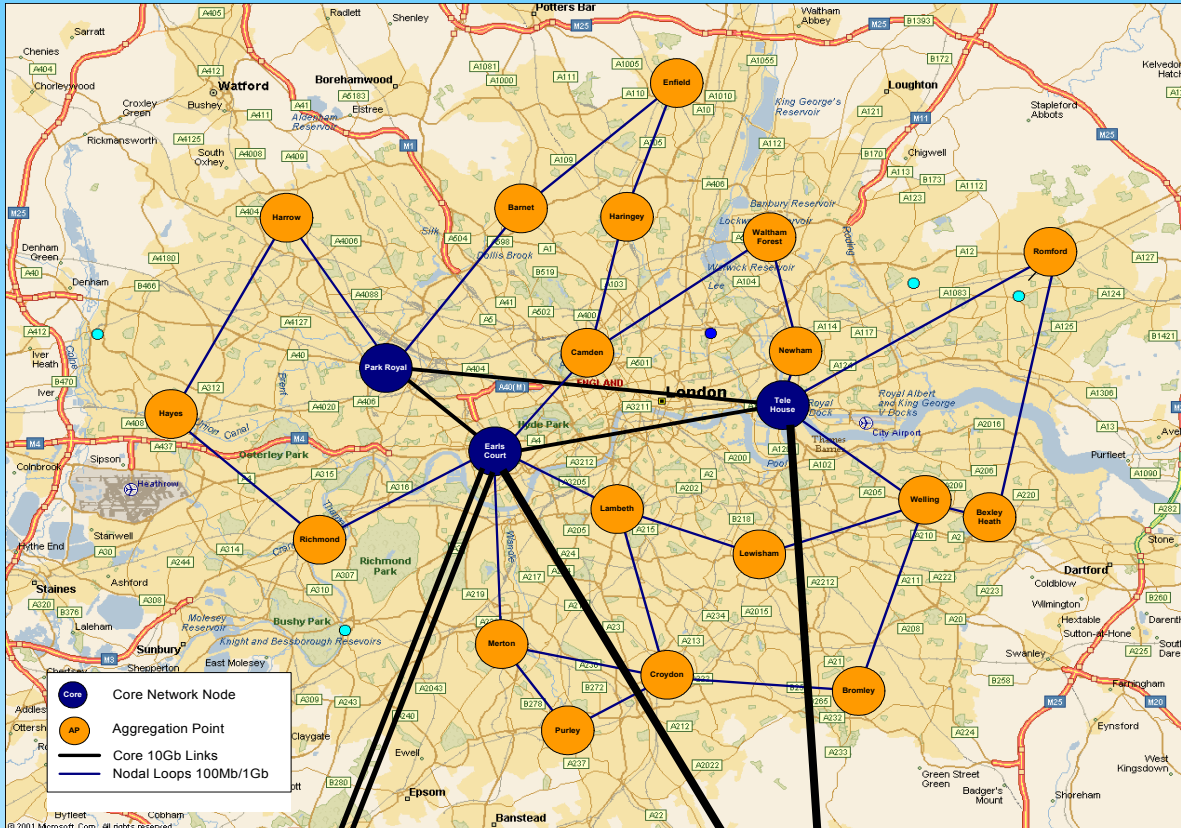

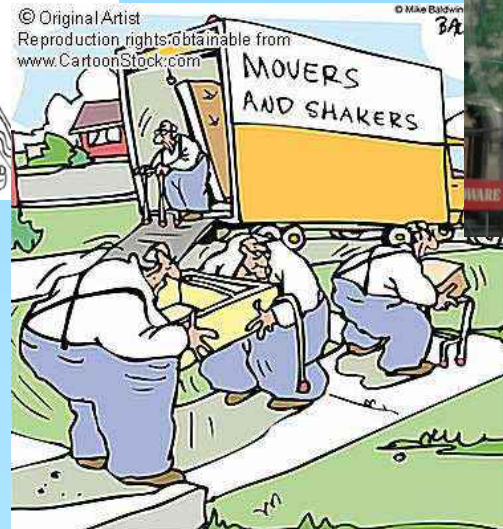
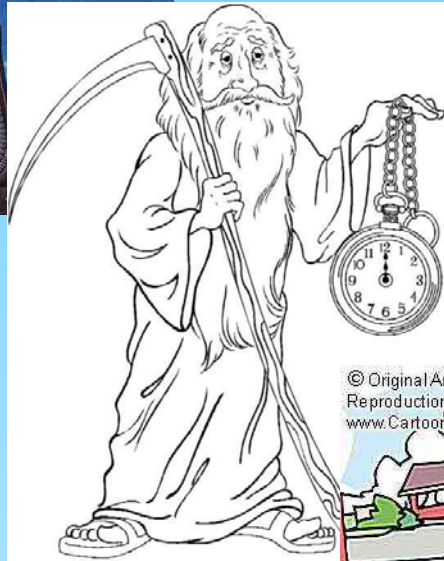
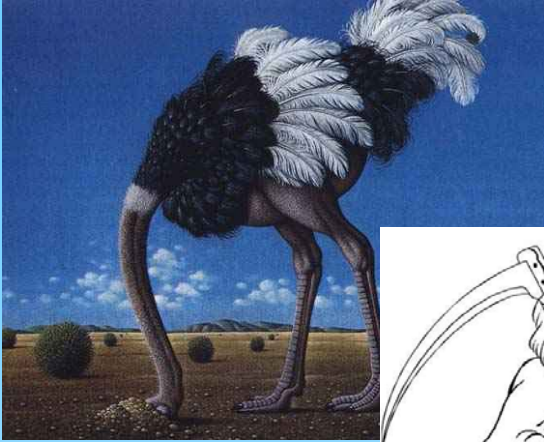
Pilot Projects
