






N3 for NHS network in England and Scotland, JANET for Education & Research







Sessions initiated in N3, "Any N3" through "Any port" but to early adopter IP addresses only





The New N3 Gateway(s)



- The new N3 JANET Gateway Service is being implemented:
 - Very soon = 21st May? or 1st week of June
 - 2 Gateways at 250 Mbps active/standby
 - Joint funded with DH/Connecting for Health
 - All N3 JANET traffic (sessions initiated in N3, routed away from internet G/way)
 - Contract for 5 years
 - Full service management by N3







And so.....



- Early adopter will carry on until the new Gateway takes over (routing switch handled centrally)
- PIDs to be started in June for follow-on projects:
 - strategic videoconferencing solutions e.g.
 - Interface new N3 vc service with JVCS?
 - IOCOM/Access Grid solution?
 - "sessions initiated in JANET"
