




### The Good News



- The new N3 JANET Gateway Service has been ordered:
  - 2 Gateways at 250 Mbps active/standby
  - Joint funded with Connecting for Health
  - All N3 JANET traffic (sessions initiated in N3)
  - Timescale to be available by the end of the month ("Spring 2010")
  - Full service management

# And so.....



- Early adopter will carry on until the new Gateway takes over (routing switch handled centrally)
- Any development of the videoconferencing will be a separate business case









- Infrastructure a renewed spur to work on "sessions initiated in JANET" along with the other main drivers, such as RCP

# Federated Access Management and the UK federation



#### FAM is:

A mechanism for allowing attribute based access control to local, national and international resources

'Student @ OU' not 'Henry Hughes' – what SPs need

#### The UK federation is:

The UK's educational federation, operated by JANET(UK) Funded by JISC and Becta

Many federations now being established worldwide Education, government, commercial participation







# Terminology



### **Authentication (AuthN)**

Is a user who they say they are?

- Identity

### **Authorization (AuthZ)**

What is the user allowed to access?

- Rights







### What is Shibboleth?



An initiative to develop an open source, standards-based solution to meet the needs for organisations to exchange information about their users in a secure, privacy-preserving manner.







### What is it used for?



- 1. Allows a browser user to access protected online resources based on information asserted by their home organisation.
- 2. Authentication and authorisation mechanism providing access control to online resources.








## "Legacy" AuthN & AuthZ





User's identity and personal data are known to all Publisher knows more than it wants and less than it needs








## Federated AuthN & AuthZ





User's identity and personal data are protected Publisher knows exactly what it needs



(764 members of the federation today)
