## What is the PSBA?


- The Welsh Public Sector Broadband Aggregation project
- wide area networking and associated services
  - services include data, voice and video conferencing
- shared resources for the public sector in Wales

## Where did the PSBA come from?

- three founding sectors
  - Health (through Informing Health Care)
  - Higher & Further Education (through JANET)
  - Local Government (Unitary Authorities)
- two legacy networks (LLNW and DAWN2)
- collaborative procurement to combine and replace the legacy networks
- Welsh Assembly Government financial contribution to build it

#### Initial Order

- HE&FE 51 connections
- Health 998 connections
- UAs
   22 connections (to Council Offices)

## Beyond the Initial Order

- over 700 new connections:
  - CCW, RCT, Blaenau Gwent, Dyfed Powys Police, Gwynedd, Denbighshire...

#### Structured Growth Plan

- three-year plan to bring in all public-sector sites



## What does the PSBA deliver?

- a collaborative shared service
- demonstrable best value for money
  - through joint procurement and operation
- strong collaborative governance model
- mechanism to drive collaborative outcomes
- enabler for collaborative service delivery
  - technical collaboration
  - commercial collaboration
  - governance collaboration



## Where PSBA enables – examples:

## videoconferencing

- tertiary education and health have own national systems
- merging into one public-sector wide system

enabler: sector expertise plus common governance

#### Tamiflu distribution

 access to NHS network from community distribution sites on local government networks

enabler: single network architecture and operator



## **Observations**

- England: interconnecting separate networks
  - largely supplier driven
  - issue is defining interfaces
    - for example: JANET/N3 gateway, local government connection to N3 and GCSx
  - evolution is toward Cabinet Office's PSN model
- Wales: common infrastructure and governance
  - increasingly driven by the public sector
  - issue is defining shared-service management models
  - evolution is towards a single shared network & services
