Enabling Teaching and Learning Strategy: The Vision

- High Bandwidth academic network connections to at least 8 clinical teaching sites
- Videoconference systems (fixed and mobile) at academic and clinical teaching sites (IP not ISDN)

- Stage 1 part of Early Adopter Group
