
Video Conferencing in the NHS

- Supporting Telehealth To improve the quality of services for patients. Local access to services.
- Professional education and development
- To improve access to Clinical expertise in rural areas,
- Produce Efficiency savings by reducing travel

But Video services seen as unreliable and difficult to use



VC in NHSScotland c 2009



- What's your Number.... I don't know mine.
- "Where's the remote....."
- "I can see you but I cant hear you"
- "I've never been able to dial them before so lets just continue without them"



Multiple Instances, no Management system, no directory



National Video Conferencing Pilot

- Makes use of existing NHSBoard equipment.
- National Directory and Local conference booking
 - Automatically populated from NHSBoard systems
 - Available on line
 - Making it easier to book and start a conference
- Conversion from ISDN to IP
 - National Video Gatekeeper Service
 - Routes Board A to Board B Video over N3.
 - Improving the video quality.
- Trial with NHSGrampian. Highland, Tayside, Western Isles, Orkney and Shetland

Local NHSBoard Support continues.



Pilot - What would be provided

- A National Gatekeeper and Management System
 - Enables National Directory and migration to N3.
 - Licences for around 300 devices
 - 1 year support of above equipment
 - Installation and testing
- Developing standards
- Not in scope:
 - National MCU (or Bridging service)
 - Gateway (IP- ISDN)
 - Licences for Boards out-with trial



VC Estate Analysis - 2009

A further estimated 200 Devices have been bought.




Agreed Gatekeeper Architecture

- Hierarchy structure
- One National (NHSScotland) Gatekeeper
- Optional NHSboard Gatekeepers
- NHSBoards can register direct to National Gatekeeper
- Appropriate number plan to facilitate.



Gatekeeper Hierarchy – Pilot



Each VC device will have a six digit extension



VC Progress

- National Directory and Gatekeeper System live.
 - 5th November 2011
 - 457 Endpoints registered at September 11
- Standards agreed and implemented across entire pilot estate
 - Dial plan based on JANet numbering scheme
 - Directory naming convention.
- Remote access capability added in July 2011
 - Enables staff to work from home or on the move.
- North of Scotland Pilot considered complete August 11
- Pressure to extend to Non NoS Boards
 - Infrastructure upgraded to support 1000 end points
 - Support extended to June 2012
 - Over 80 Non NoS Boards end points on Directory
 - 75% of NHS Boards have converted to N3







On Line Map




Live interactive map using Bing Maps

Some outstanding Issues

- Bandwidth Availability and affordability in rural areas
- End to end Video service support
 - Variable End User/end device support
 - Some NHSBoards have no dedicated support staff
 - Multi-conferencing management
 - No formal SLAs between NHSBoards.
 - No Business Continuity no buddy arrangements
- Code of Connection
 - Agreement on need for standards. E.g. Minimum Bandwidth
- Absence of a Video services strategy for patients
- Connectivity via IP with JANet and other sectors.
- Room based PC based Integration
 - Numerous PC based Collaborative tools being deployed



What happens next?

- Dial plan implemented to the rest of Scotland.
 - Enough national gatekeeper licences
- Directory Management System extension require further procurement.
- ISDN to IP Central gateway.
- IP Connectivity with JANet and Scottish Government
 - Looking at a Guest process for IP and ISDN access.
- Support Video communications to Patients?
 - COPD rehab, Stroke, Decision support using Movi
- Start Business Case
 - Workshop complete in June
 - Service, including room and conference support
 - Functionality, e.g. Integration with desktop video
 - Long list of Options by 20th October.



Beyond N3



Beyond N3 Background

- N3 Contract
 - Last orders April 13
 - Last service April 16
- Contract can be extended by a further year
 - However only England can make this decision
 - Creates uncertainty.
- Need to start planning now.

NHS

PSN

- PSN (Public Sector Network)
- Network of Networks
- Multiple suppliers
- Common Security standards across public sector
 - Debate with NHS on standards ongoing
 - Concerns about security standards
- SG looking at a SPSN
 - Option for N3 replacement
 - Public Sector Network for Scotland
- Awaiting SG response to McClelland
 - Probably October before position is clear

Meanwhile NHSScotland to look at life beyond N3



Beyond N3 Progress

- NHSBoard high level requirements workshops complete
- Report to e-Health leads
- Detailed Statement of Requirement
- Initial agreement in November
- Also SPSN starting
 - Information gathering
- Strategy to run with NHS only and SPSN for now but requirements need to be developed either option.



Common issues and Concerns

	Key Risks & Issues	Comments
1	Service Continuity	Biggest concern. National and local applications will be around for 7 years. Need to start procurement in September
2	Transition Costs	Who Pays
3	Fragmentation across NHSScotland	Increase in Core and common network services cost, if we don't stick together.
4	Loss of aggregation	Potential Increase Core and common services costs if we divorce NHSEngland and don't get another partner.
5	Imposed standards from 3 rd parties	Need to take the lead. Cant sit back and let that happen. Existing standards well developed.
6	Sharing at local level	L.A's all different. Not at expense of sharing with NHS.
7	SPSN	What is it and when will it be available. Health should decide and influence.
8	Term of Contract	7 Years + extensions . Avoids future transition cost



Common Requirement - from Regional

Item	Comments
Network Traffic trends	Will remain Local and national. Difficult to predict, use historical data from N3 and project forward.
Demand Drivers	Teleheath to Patients homes, Imaging, virtual desktop environment, inter Board video, portal inter regional and/or board, local PMS back-up, Sharing with LAs.
Internet Connectivity	Benefits of a single connection for NHSScotland provided access control and content delivery devolved locally
Remote Access	Need to allow local remote access solutions through and any future NHSScotland Internet arrangement.
Shared Services	Network must support complex traffic flows.
Voice & Video services	Not convinced that Voice or video services should be brought into a WAN contract. Network needs to support good quality Voice & Video.
Service Level requirements	Don't need such high SLAs for Pharmacists and Dentists. May go to Internet. Higher service levels for Hospitals.



Recommendations

- A decision on NHS involvement in SPSN (Scottish Public Service Network) needs to be made by September or else N3 contract will need to be extended another year or start procurement.
- A detailed Statement of Requirement should be developed within the eHealth leads infrastructure group.

NHSmail

- Independent Consultants declare NHSmail good value
 - But concerns about licensing costs.
- Service ends in June 2013
- Business case process has started
 - Initial agreement October 2011
 - Looking at Cloud options
