Highlights or main differences;

- -All Staff need to complete training.
- -12hr Turn around for report of Breach/incident?
- -Tested continuity which includes Disaster recovery /breach incidents.
- -No unsupported Operating Systems or Internet Browsers
- -Cyber Essentials Accreditation
