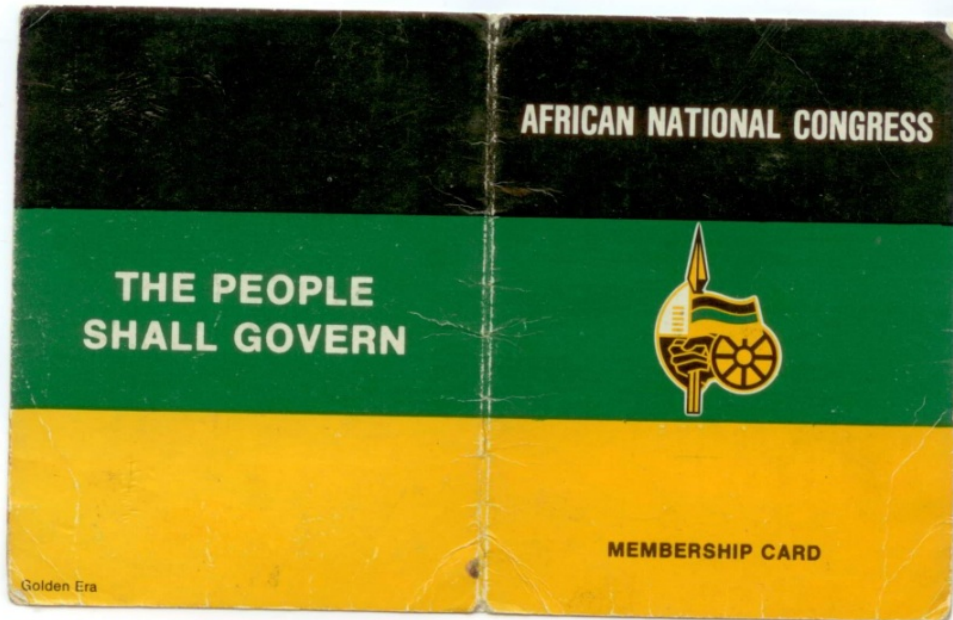
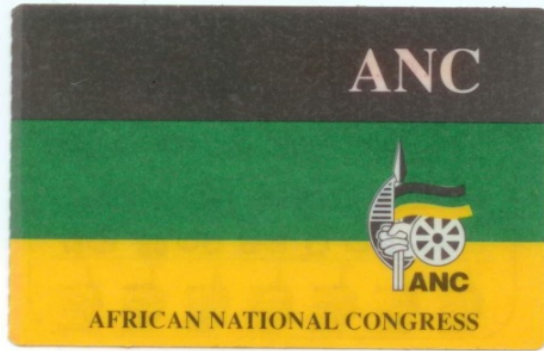

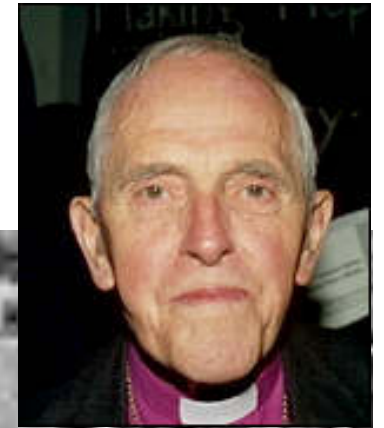

ANC unbanned

FW's sweeping measures

- Unbanned ANC, PAC, SA Communist Party
- Exiled members free to return to South Africa
- Imprisoned members to go free
- All executions suspended
- Death penalty should no longer be mandatory
- Restrictions lifted on 33 organizations — including UDF, Cope, National Education Council, SA National Student Congress, and Bantu Beroepsbeweging van SA
- Conditions imposed on 374 people released from detention scrapped
- Media regulations abolished — except censored war "visual material on arms"
- Education emergency regulations scrapped
- State of emergency to be terminated on

THE African National Congress, the Pan Africanist Congress, the South African Communist Party and a number of other organisations are being unbanned, President De Klerk announced today.

Opening parliament, he also said that political prisoners were to be released and media restrictions would largely be lifted.

He made an hour statement in a regular talk to parliament. He said the government would take a decision about some bills.
